## *White Wines by the Glass*

### *Sauvignon Blanc "Domine Galetis" 2018 (France) ABV 12%*

The intense nose of this wine offers flavoursome aromas of grapefruit, lemon and passion fruit, backed by vegetal nuances of boxwood and gorse, underscored by a distinct mineral note. Well balanced with a fruity finish.

### *Chardonnay, Norte Chico 2019 (Chile) ABV 12.5%*

Unoaked white, mineral nose & a hint of tropical flavours of pineapple & banana, balanced by a refreshing acidity.

## *Rosé Wines by the Glass*

*Zinfandel Rosé 'Borrego Springs' 2016 (California, USA)*  
*ABV 10.5%*

Pale rose pink, soft & juicy aromas of fresh red currants, aromatic cherries and white peaches. Crisp acidity on the palate combines with red berry, cranberry & strawberry flavours. Light bodied with good length and well balanced with acidity to sugar.

### ***Rioja "Rivallana" 2018 (Spain) ABV 13%***

An intense oak aged Rioja with deep flavours of cherries, plums and vanilla. Aged in French and American oak barrels for a full year before bottling.

### *Clean & Crisp*

#### *Malvasia "Vina Kozlović", Istria 2018 (Croatia) ABV 12%*

A bright, transparent, green-yellow colour. Intense aroma with many layers. A profound scent of peach followed by refined herbal notes. On the palate, nectarine, melon and red apples. The finish gives way to a light nuttiness. The Kozlović family invite you to sample the fruits of their labour.

#### *White Rioja, Tempranillo Blanco (Spain) 2018 ABV 13.5%*

A full-bodied creamy wine showing incredible minerality and zesty citrus which washes down with hints of white flowers and spicy notes. Prominent mineral characters with appealing green apple, citrus and tropical fruits linger on the long and precise finish.

#### *Muscadet Serve et Maine, Loire 2018 (France) ABV 12.5%*

Surprising aroma of citrus and white flowers, with slight spritz and a long, distinctly saline finish. Unlike any other Muscadet, being sulphur-free, gives this wine a unique flavour like you have never tasted.

*Chardonnay, Saint Clair Family Estate, (Marlborough N.Z.)  
2019 ABV 13%*

A fantastic vintage with perfect weather conditions! One of the Snooty Taverns' favourite vineyards having visited and seen the professional care and nurture of the wine production ourselves.

Elegantly complex, with notes of peach, hazelnut, toffee & almond combined with impressions of oyster shell and oak spice. In our minds, one of the greatest representations of a Chardonnay we have come across!

*Dry & Mineral*

*Picpoul de Pinet, "Tournée du Sud" 2019 (France) 12.5%*

The literal translation of Picpoul is 'lip-stinger' because of its freshness. A Mediterranean white with all the salty, lemony, floral finesse of the zippy picpoul grape. Slightly steely and lemony on the nose with an unusual depth on the palate which finishes with a long refreshing taste which is fantastic with seafood.

*Chardonnay Grande Ardeche, Louis Latour 2018 (France)  
ABV 13.5%*

Beautiful straw yellow hue revealing intense nose of toast, vanilla and acacia flower. Creamy and buttery with a round balanced taste and a fresh almond finish.

*Sancerre, Domaine Regis Jouan White Loire 2019 (France)  
ABV 13.5%*

Hosting striking notes of grapefruit, green apples & elderflower with a buttery, creamy palate and a juicy finish. For someone who enjoys Sancerre, we promise you will not go away disappointed! A wine coming from the second oldest appellation in France.

*Meursault 1er Cru "Chateau de Blagny" Maison Louis Latour 2010 (France) ABV 13.5%*

With the colour of pale gold this wine has a powerful, clean nose of citrus fruits and toasty aromas. Nice length on the finish with a mineral finale. Aged for 8 to 10 months in oak barrels giving a deep biscuit and toffee element.

Louis Latour was founded in 1797, known for harvesting, ageing & bottling some of the finest wines of Burgundy. Situated just south of Volnay and Pommard in the Côte de Beaune, Meursault is the most extensive southerly white wine commune of the Côte-d'Or.

*Sauvignon Blanc "Domine Galetis" 2018 (France) ABV 12%*

## *Rose Wines*

*Zinfandel Rosé ‘Borrego Springs’ 2016 (California, USA)*  
*ABV 10%*

Pale rose pink, soft & juicy aromas of fresh redcurrants, cherries and white peaches. Crisp acidity on the palate yet light bodied with good length and well balanced with acidity to sugar.

The elegant rosé has a refreshing acidity and a long finish. This wine is perfect with Mediterranean & Asiatic dishes.

## *Red Wines Full & Bold*

*Rioja "Rivallana" 2018 (Spain) ABV 13%*

An intense oak aged Rioja with deep flavours of cherries, plums and vanilla. Aged in French & American oak barrels for a year before bottling.

*Shiraz, Tahbilk, Victoria 2017 (Australia) ABV 13.5%*

Beautifully pungent nose of spice and juicy cherry. Matured in French oak barrels leaving earthy spiced notes on the pallet accompanied with plum and blackberry fruits with great length.

*Appassimento, Ca Vittoria, Puglia 2019 (Italy) ABV 14.5%*

Fantastic bottle containing intense black fruits on the nose with a touch of vanilla. Twice passed over Amarone grapes to give a unique finish. A bold juicy wine which is perfect with steaks.

*Mulderbosch, Cabernet Franc, Stellenbosch 2016 (S.A.) 14%*

Beautifully rich & amazingly smooth with spiced black fruit and very balanced tannins. Bold & deep with complexity and great length with tobacco and hints of liquorice. A fantastic wine from a famous region.

***Pomerol 'Chateau Beauregard' 2013 (France) ABV 13.5%***

Pomerol is regarded as one of the top five wines in the world. A very bold in flavour but light & silky with intense juicy black fruits on the nose. A long-lasting finish accompanied by a hint of dryness. This exceptional wine hosts the complexity of leather, tobacco and pepper spice with finely edged tannin. A wine that is perfectly balanced that will certainly live up to expectations.

## *Fruity & Juicy*

***Malbec "El Camino" 2018 (Mendoza, Argentina) ABV 14.5%***

On the nose, it shows intense spicy and sweet aromas together with red fruit notes and floral violet hints. With a soft, velvety and very well balanced fresh finish. Beautiful with red meats or pasta.

***Merlot Gran Reserva, Echeverría 2018 (Chile) ABV 14.5%***

Full-bodied with a silky, savoury and earthy style. Eucalyptus and red plums on the palate. Herbal notes and coffee tones through to a rounded finish. Hand-harvested grapes which spend 10 months in French oak.

***Beaujolais Cru, Juliéna, Domaine de la Vieille Eglise 2017 (France) ABV 13.5%***

Relaxed but complex wine with a beautiful soft vanilla nose hosting cherry, blackcurrant and a slightly woody end. Very juicy and fresh on the pallet which is soft & light with a persistent finish.

## *Oaked, Smoked & Peppery*

*St Chinian, 'Heritage' Gerard Bertrand 2018 (France) ABV 14.5%*

A fantastic wine by a top vineyard. A complex bouquet of cocoa, laurel, tobacco, black pepper and black fruits makes this wine one not to miss. A light but full wine with elegant tannins lead to a long velvety finish.

*Tempranillo Reserva "Castillo de Calatrava" 2015 (Spain) ABV 13%*

Aged for over 3 years in oak barrels and bottle resulting in a luscious intense red. Rich in fruit aromas with a lingering, slightly spicy finish. A fantastic wine for such a price.

*Pinotage "Olifantsberg" 2017 (South Africa) ABV 13%*

Medium-bodied with a fresh berry nose with a hint of smoke. A very well-balanced and smooth palate complemented by a sweet spice to go well with a fusion of spiced food.

*Massaya Classic 2011 (Lebanon, Bekaa Valley) ABV 14.5%*

A perfect blend of Cinsault 60%, Cabernet Sauvignon 20% and Syrah 20%. One of two great wines on our list from Lebanon. With soft spices, juicy red fruits, medium tannin and a velvety finish, this wine is incredible value for money.

*Côte de Bergerac "Château de Peytirat" 2017 ABV 12.5%*

*Wine Exclusive to The Snooty Tavern*

A silky-smooth wine with hints of blackberries, raspberries and stone fruit, from Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The strength effortlessly compliments duck, red meats and is also great with strong cheeses.

***Monemvasia Winery Tsimbidi, Monemvasios, Laconia Agiorgitiko, Mavroudi 2009 (Greece) ABV 13%***

Well matured by the makers in new oak for a year; then bottle matured for several more. A Malvasia wine - for which Monemvasia is the local translation. Deep ruby in colour, velvety texture, with cherry, mocha, vanilla and nutty-oak flavours. This wine goes famously with spiced Lamb dishes.

***Grand Malbec "Piattelli" 2017 (Argentina) ABV 14.5%***

A rich and fragrant wine which represents the best of their crop. An intense red with aromas of strong black fruits, vanilla oak, and a touch of smoke. These aromas are transferred on the palate to give the wine superb structure with a full body that doesn't disappoint. A soft fruit-forward flavour leads to a strong and well balanced finish. You will be left wanting more.

***Chateau Musar 2000 (Lebanon) ABV 14%***

The character is dense, richly-textured, with intense 'baked fruit' flavours of plums, damsons, cranberries, fig and dates.

The Hochar family produce this wonderful wine from their winery in Ghazir, 15 miles north of the capital, Beirut. The founder, Serge Hochar's sons manage the day to day running of the winery. Marc explains "My brother looks after the liquid. I look after the liquidity" The Musar grapes are grown in sunny Bekaa Valley at an altitude of 3000 ft all waiting to be hand- harvested.

### *Pinot Noir "Tournee du Sud" 2019 (France) ABV 12.5%*

Delectable on the palate with fruit and chocolate flavours. Aromas of soft red fruits with a beautiful light ruby colour. A lovely light and smooth red that still has body to drink alongside your meal

The combination of ripe red fruits, gunflint, and smoky notes creates a lovely balance. To the palate its very chewy texture along with pleasant freshness supported by positive, wooded tannins.

### *Muscat de St-Jean-de Minervoís 2012, Petit Grain (France) ABV 15%*

Boasting the ripest bunch of raisined grapes squeezed into your glass from Languedoc-Roussillon! Deliciously honied and fruit, rather than sugar-sweet so not cloying - with a kick of lemony freshness.

### *Quady Muscat "Elysium" 2015 (California) ABV 15%*

## Champagne

### *Champagne Chimère Brut (France) ABV 12%*

A classic champagne produced from Chardonnay, Pinot Nior and Pinot Meunier – aged for a minimum of 15 months before release. It has a beautiful aroma of fruity white flowers, flattered with light, delicate bubbles. On the palate it is fresh with biscuit notes and a long, elegant finish.

### *English Sparkling Wine*

#### *Sugrue Pierre, South Downs Brut 2011 (England) ABV 12%*
